Secretary Murphy to make decision at December 18 State Board of Education meeting following public comment period The Delaware Department of Education's Charter School Accountability Committee today recommended not to renew Reach Academy and Gateway Lab School's charters at the end of this academic year because of poor academic performance at both schools.

In other recommendations, the committee supported renewal of the following charter schools: Delaware Academy of Public Safety and Security, EastSide Charter School, Family Foundations Academy, Las Américas ASPIRA Academy and Odyssey Charter School.

Academic Excellence Committee Update

The following initiatives have been implemented to address teacher effectiveness:

- Effective 7/1/14, Beth Anne Gluck was hired as Dean of Instruction to focus on curricular and teacher development.
- Themes for the year are Sheltered Instruction, Common Core implementation, Teaching for Biliteracy, use of technological tools to increase effectiveness and data-driven instruction.
- LAAA adopted Edivation (formerly PD360) to use for both instructional coaching and DPAS II evaluation.
- ECO (Educator Collaboration Opportunity) meetings are held monthly with grade-level teams. Topics include, but are not limited to, using data to inform instruction and enhancing team collaboration.
- PD (professional development) Days are held monthly (8 hour day). An agenda is established by the Dean of Instruction and Head of School to ensure training is targeted based on individual needs.
- Grant has been secured through the University of Delaware for teacher development in the Responsive Classroom method. PD Days in January and February will be dedicated to this training.

LAAA Brand Building Campaign Update
