The ADCO board was given three great presentations by the organizations mentioned above. Experience, cost, pricing effectiveness, knowledge of market, local presence, current debt, preliminary credit ratings, pitfalls and pre-payment penalties (\$290,000) were all discussed. Jorge had also discussed this process with the Chair and Vice-Chair of the board before tonight's meeting. Who do you want representing ASPIRA to sell the bonds?

A motion by Patton, seconded by Laznik that the ADCO Board select RW Baird/Buck Financial to be the underwriters for the issuance of Bonds for ASPIRA Academy. Final resolution was unanimous.

### Enrollment update

- Lottery conducted on Saturday, January 30<sup>th</sup>; 90 K students invited to enroll; remaining students placed on wait list
- Families of the 90 students invited to attend K have until March 18<sup>th</sup> to accept/decline the invitation and complete the registration packet. In addition, they must attend one of the following orientation sessions: March 3<sup>rd</sup> or March 16<sup>th</sup> and have their child complete the assessment in August (prior to start of school year).
- All invitations and wait list e-mails and letters were sent/mailed February 17<sup>th</sup> by Data Service Center. Includes applications received by January 13<sup>th</sup> and included in the lottery.
- E-mails and letters for applications received after January 13 (not included in the lottery) were sent/mailed on February 24<sup>th</sup> by LAAA. We will continue monitoring the new applications and will send the e-mail/letter with the wait list number to those families accordingly.

### Staffing Update

- Projected staffing changes/needs for 2016-2017
  - Enrollment "bubble" will move from 2<sup>nd</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> to 5<sup>th</sup>; therefore, we anticipate the following changes:
    - 2 teachers (English and Spanish Immersion) will move from 4<sup>th</sup> to 5<sup>th</sup> to fill the staffing need due to the bubble
    - 2 teachers (English and Spanish Immersion) will need to be hired to fill new positions in 3<sup>rd</sup> grade due to the bubble
  - Immersion program moves into 6<sup>th</sup> grade; therefore, we anticipate the following changes in instruction to support the biliteracy model with existing staff:
    - English Language Arts & Humanities
    - Spanish Language Arts & Humanities
    - Math (taught in English)
    - Science (taught in English)
  - Creation of Literacy Coach position (Emily Edmonds-Eveland) to support instructional goals, which will result in an open position in 2<sup>nd</sup> grade (English Immersion).
  - Addition of another school nurse (PT) to support Debbie Holstein based on increased enrollment.
- Job posting is currently active for English and Spanish Immersion Teacher (grades K-5) to generate resumes for anticipated new/open positions (noted in RED).
- Additional changes to staffing will be needed based on finalized budget and confirmed resignations/terminations.
