Call to Order

Gus Rivera called the public session to order at 6:00PM. He noted that there were five voting-eligible Directors present and that a quorum was established. References hereunder to "unanimous" actions of the board refer to the actions of the five present voting-eligible Directors.

Public comment:

Miss Tomlinson (5th grade parent) presented two issues.

- 1) Teacher/student/parent/administration communication
- 2) Parental involvement for homework in immersion program (K-2)/second language (3-6)

Discussion occurred. Board thanked Ms. Tomlinson for her attendance and thought the issues discussed were extremely important and need to be addressed.

<u>Approval of Minutes:</u> Minutes of the April 25, 2013 Board Meeting were presented and reviewed. Goldstein presented a motion to accept the April Meeting Minutes as presented which was seconded by Heesters. The motion to approve the minutes was approved by unanimous vote of the Board.

<u>Finance Committee Report (FOC)</u> as reported by Greg Panchisin (Board Treasurer/Chair of the Financial Oversight Committee position is vacant – until filled, G Panchisin will present finance reports)

Greg reviewed the April monthly financial report as approved by the FOC and provided an update on the FOC. Actual to budget remains favorable. Several questions were raised and answered. Full report is available on the FOC portion of www.aspiraacademy.org. A motion by Goldstein, seconded by Heesters that the ADCO Board accept the April 2013 Monthly Financial Report as presented. Final resolution was unanimous.

Building Hope loan is in the final stages of approval.

Longwood Foundation granted LAAA \$350,000 for Phase 2 construction. THANK YOU!

Construction contract has been reduced to approximately 1.1 million.

Construction has begun for Phase 2 with current funding.

Full Phase 2 construction contract can't be completed until loan is approved.

Laznik presented a motion to accept Jorge Diaz as board treasurer which was seconded by Goldstein.

Aaron Goldstein is working with Greg Panchisin to put in place corrective actions, specifically sections 12-5 and 12-6 to review the by-laws and put a bid policy in place.

Topic of the school name "Las Americas ASPIRA Academy" discussion continued. ASPIRA of Delaware Charter Operations Inc. (ADCO) will be discussing this issue more extensively at a future meeting to determine the pros and cons of any type of change.
