Cell Phone Policy/Usage

To ensure instructional time is maximized, phones (and earbuds) will not be permitted to be used or out during class time. Phones are permitted before and after school and during a student's 30 minute lunch period. Please review the bell schedule above to identify times when students are and are not permitted to use their cell phones.

Back to School Night

Wednesday, August 23 from 6:00 to 7:30 PM. Students will receive their Chromebook (if insurance has been paid and the acceptable use agreement has been completed online), get their class schedule, pick up parking passes, and get a tour the building.

Student Schedules

Student schedules will be available through Home Access Center (HAC) on August 24th - anything prior to this date is subject to change and may not be accurate. Students may access HAC directly using their student account. Parents who have created a Home Access account will be able to view schedules as well. Parents who have yet to set up an account for Home Access Center are encouraged to do so by completing the online registration for an account found HERE.

<u>Upon receiving your schedule, changes will only be made if space is available in the requested course and one of the following apply:</u> sequence of courses; and/or previous failures. All schedules are made based upon transcript information, test scores, course availability, and student requests. Parents and students should understand that <u>schedules are TENTATIVE until the first day of school</u>. Teachers and course periods may change. Please note that summer school grades are still being processed. Schedules for students enrolled in summer school will be adjusted appropriately after these grades are received. If there are any conflicts, the guidance counselor and administration will be available to assist.

If students need a schedule change based on the conditions stated above, they **must** complete a "Request to Change Schedule" form which will be available outside Mrs. Torres' office The forms will be date stamped and she will process requests based only on the order in which forms are received. Schedule change requests must be submitted by the end of the 3rd day of school to allow for processing time. No schedule change requests will be accepted after the 3rd day of school.

Student Chromebooks

Chromebooks insurance must be paid for students to receive a Chromebook. Payments can be made online <u>using this link</u>. Chromebooks will not be distributed at the Back to school Night event to students who have not made the insurance payment by August 4, 2023. Student's whose families pay the Chromebook insurance after this date will receive their Chromebook on the first student school day. No Chromebooks will be distributed without a signed online technology agreement. Personal devices **are not permitted** and will not be able to access the school's WiFi.

Parking Passes

Students who are 16, and have completed their 6 months of supervised driving are permitted to drive to and from school. There are approximately 30 spots available for student drivers, and registration is first come first served. Parking passes cost \$30. Students who do not receive a parking pass are not permitted to drive to school. Please note that by accepting a parking pass you will waive your student's bus privileges. Students interested in a parking pass should complete the <u>online application</u>. Passes can be picked up during Back to School Night.

- Please use the tentative schedule for planning purposes and know that dates are subject to change. Please do not schedule vacations or appointments during exam times.

Exam Policy Reminders

- Make-up exam opportunities will be granted only with a valid medical note or preapproval by the administration. (Do not schedule vacations on exam days)
- Daily attendance is required for all students in all classes until the last day of each semester. (Remember students must be in attendance at least 90% of the course time to earn credit)

ASPIRA Charter High School (ACHS) will host our Fall Open House on September 19, 2023. We will have a brief whole group meeting in the gym at 6:30 pm followed by an opportunity to visit with your child's teachers. You will be provided valuable information about your child's classes, your student's teachers and your student's progress thus far. A detailed schedule will be provided closer to the event.
