Position Description:

English Immersion Teachers follow a 50/50 immersion model and provide core instruction in content areas (English, Math, Social Studies) to two homeroom classes on alternating days providing instruction entirely in English while their counterpart provides instruction in Spanish.

- Design and implement summative assessments to measure progress towards academic standards and formative assessments to drive instruction.
- Use assessment data to inform curricular and instructional practices.
- Create a positive, achievement-oriented learning environment following the responsive classroom approach.
- Reflect on successes and areas of growth as a teacher, seek to improve performance, and respond to feedback.
